



PORT OF BEAULIEU PLAISANCE

REQUEST FOR LIQUID COLLECTION AND TANK MAINTENANCE

- **Delivery procedure:**
 - The company involved must send the collection request to the Port Office at least 24 hours before the operation.
 - All requests must indicate the vessel concerned, the type of liquid and the quantity.
 - All operations must be carried out between 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m., except on Mondays for vessels under 20 m.
 - A maximum of two trucks will be authorised to carry out the operation.
- **Delivery areas :**
 - Careening area for boats under 20 metres.
 - Quai du Levant for boats over 20 metres.
- **Intervention procedure:**
 - Intervention vehicles must park in the spaces indicated by the Port Office. Under no circumstances should they disrupt traffic on the embankments.
 - A safety perimeter must be set up using any appropriate means (two-colour cones, barrier tape, mobile posts, etc.).
 - The ship's captain and crew must set up connections, fire extinguishers suitable for the product, leak recovery equipment and oil absorption equipment such as absorbent pads (dispersants are strictly prohibited).
 - The ship's captain and crew must agree with the responders on the emergency fire or pollution shutdown procedure, as well as on safety instructions such as no smoking, no telephoning, etc.
 - Surveillance during operations is mandatory and will be carried out jointly by the ship's captain and crew and the responders, sharing responsibilities.
 - In the event of an accidental spill that could cause pollution, the ship's captain and crew must immediately inform the Port office.
 - Throughout the operations, the vessel must display the regulatory markings and lights and remain on standby on VHF channel 09.
- **End of operation:**
 - The driver must leave the delivery area clean and free of any pollutants.
 - The driver and the ship's captain must inform the Port office about the end of the operation and about any pollution that may have been emitted.
